

Detroit Country Day scored two touchdowns in the first quarter Saturday, and then hung on to defeat Cranbrook, 14-0, for their first win over the Cranbrook team in the school's previous 10 meetings. Country Day had managed just one tie while losing nine times.

Chris Vaidler was the hero for the Yellow Jackets, catching three passes for 114 yards and one touchdown. The touchdown pass, covering 36 yards, was delivered from quarterback Rob Ambrose, who was injured near the end of the first half. The Ambrose injury left a somber note to an otherwise happy occasion for Country Day.

"Ambrose's status is still questionable," said DCD coach Gene Reilly. "Losing a guy like Ambrose, who is a super leader and a great athlete, has got to have an effect on you. He does all the extra things he's the first player at practice and the last one to leave."

Running back Tom Rosenfield was another good performer for the Yellow Jackets as he gained 73 yards in just six carries and scored one of the DCD touchdowns on a four-yard run.

Overall, Country Day outgained Cranbrook in total yardage, 287-127.

ALL OF CRANBROOK'S scoring came in the third quarter. Steve Maxwell started it by catching DCD reserve quarterback Jeff Johnson in the end zone for a safety. Then Crane QB Dan Hazen hit fullback Jay Jelle with a 15-yard strike to bring Cranbrook within eight points, but the Cranbrook didn't master enough offense in the final period to challenge DCD.

"There's no question, we just out-played

them and out-hit them," Reilly said. "We were very concerned with our execution and technique—the basics of the game. We wanted to do what we do well, and keep doing it. There were times when we let down a little, but for the most part, our kids took care of themselves."

Former Country Day headmaster F. Allen Shaw was given the game ball by the DCD team for his inspirational speech to the team after the game.

"It was a very moving experience for everyone to have a 81-year-old headmaster come in and talk to the kids," said Reilly. "There are so many generations between him and the kids. Things like that make athletics worthwhile."

Country Day will face Lutheran West in their next game on Friday. The Jackets now have a 2-1 record, overall, and a 2-0 mark in the Metro Conference.

O.L. ST. MARY—OUR LADY OF THE LAKES

Orchard Lake St. Mary handed Waterford Our Lady of the Lakes their first defeat of the season Sunday 20-0.

St. Mary opened the scoring in the first quarter after an interception by Greg Williamson. St. Mary launched a 74-yard drive in 11 plays, capped by a 25-yard touchdown pass from Jim Paciorek to Phil Ormalowski. Tom Kovach caught a pass from Paciorek for the two-point conversion.
