JOHN ANDERSON had no trouble leading the parade in the Classic at Garden Lanes when he posted a 641 to beat Gordie Cantrell by 18 pins with Ned Beckman's 608 being good enough for third place.

In the ladies classic, Jan Dimmer showed the way with a 583 with Pat Lisowski in second place with 568 and Mary Mahan and Virginia Mega tied for third at 566.

In the other leagues at Garden Lanes, Walter Wolfe edged out Dore Andrew by a single pin with 88 to pace the Vinos curl. Dawson Hedges was top man among the senior citizens with 611, while Ron Hunter showed the way in the Wayne County loop with 624 and Bill Montgomery Sr. was top man in the Moose loop with 629.

With more than 100,000 fans jamming every inch of the big stadium, the University of Michigan team begins the serious part of its 1978 campaign Saturday afternoon when it meets Michigan State in the great intra-state rivalry.

As time draws near for the showdown in conference play, those who have watched the Wolverines in their first four games are wondering:

How good is Michigan?

Can the Maize and Blue go all the way?

Up to now, the Wolverines have been in and out of contention while running up fantastic scores. Against Navy, for instance, they looked unbeatable while piling up 70 points. Yet, last Saturday, they were sluggish and lacked the precision of the opening weeks.

Now the big question is which team will oppose Michigan State?

If it is the team that beat Wake Forest in a lackluster performance, Michigan is

liable to be in for trouble. Michigan State, under a new coach and carrying the burden of probation in the Big Ten, could cause some surprises. The Spartans have the players. It is just a question of fitting them into a productive machine.

Total now, Michigan has been playing for records while gaining the No. 1 spot in the polls. Jim Wood, the walk-on who is doing the forest kicking Michigan has seen in years, is establishing an almost unbelievable record on kickoffs. Only two so far have failed to go out of the end zone.

While he silently is building up a mark, Bob Lytle is moving up fast in the ground game. Last Saturday he passed the legendary Tom Harmon and moved into fifth place in the all-time rushing record book.

So, it could be an interesting game—unless the State defense falters and the Wolverines explode like they did against Navy.
