Grant funds study of hypertension

Federal funds totaling \$17,300 from the Michigan Department of Public Health will help launch a comprehensive coordinated program for hypertension control in the tri-county area, according to an announcement today by United Community Services of Metropolitan Detroit (UCS).

The state allocation grew out of the findings of a major study by UCS that identified the magnitude of undetected and untreated cases of hypertension as a serious health problem in the metropolitan community which could have disastrous social and economic consequences.

To help thousands of afflicted persons prevent disability or early death the UCS study called for speedy action in a plan to control hypertension through a metropolitan-wide coalition of public and voluntary health agencies, hospitals, professional and community groups, business and labor.

ACTING ON BEHALF of this coalition, UCS requested public health funds from the state to set up an ongoing mechanism for screening metropolitan residents to detect hypertensives, coordinating the necessary medical resources, and conducting public education programs aimed at prevention.

Funds just granted by the state will be shared by the local health departments as well as UCS, with \$27,000 earmarked for the initiation of specific hypertension control programs by county health departments in their respective areas.

UCS will receive \$6,250 to contract two other programs. One involves the expenditure of \$11,500 for the Detroit Department of Health to develop a computerized follow-up system on hypertensives in cases in the tri-county area and the remaining \$11,500 will be used for the coalition for the development, staffing and programs.
