 All classes will be at the Racquetball Courts of Farmington, 34200 Nine Mile west of Farmington Road. Racquets and balls are furnished. Child care is available upon request.
 Tuesday's classes are from 10-11 a.m. beginning Nov. 9. Fee is \$2. A second Tuesday class will be for night owls running from 11 p.m. to midnight.
 Thursday classes from 12 p.m. will begin Nov. 11. Fee for that class also is \$2.
 Friday classes from 7-8 p.m. will begin Nov. 13. Cost is \$30. Saturday classes will run from 7-8 p.m. and will begin Nov. 13. Cost is \$27.
 Final registration should be in by Nov. 5. Interested persons may either register by using the accompanying coupon or register at the recreation commission offices on Orchard Lake Road, just south of Eleven Mile.

Maple Street residents to speak out on paving

Maple Street residents will have yet another opportunity to voice their opinion on the paving of their street, at 8 p.m., Dec. 6, in the Farmington City Council chambers.
 When last heard from, homeowners on Maple had objected to the paving of the roadway until the 196 Freedom Road extension ramp was removed.
 The State Highway Department has completed half of the work necessary to remove the ramp. The asphalt approach was removed and material for a fence around the area has arrived, according to City Mgr. Robert Deadman.
 "We estimate the work on the closing of the ramp will be completed in the next two weeks," he said.
 In August, the city sent out a questionnaire to the Maple Street homeowners to

solid their opinion of a paving effort.
 "We found that the owners of 50 per cent of the assessable front footage were in favor of, or conditionally in favor of the paving," Deadman said.
 The nine per cent who ignored the form were included on the side of the pro-paving forces.
 Therefore, the city believes that 59 per cent of the residents want their road paved. It counts 41 per cent of the residents as being unilaterally opposed to the paving effort.
