

# Panel to answer on pets

Pet owners in Southfield and Lathrup Village will be able to pose questions concerning the health and care of their pets to a panel of veterinarians — and have the questions answered on live TV.

This new series on animal care begins at 9:30 p.m. Tuesday, Oct. 26, during the live telecast of "All About Animals" on channel 36, WTVS-TV.

Produced by the public information station in cooperation with the Southeastern Michigan Veterinary Medical Association (SEMVA), the half-hour show will be broadcast once a month.

Channel 7 news reporter Jim Herrington will moderate the show. Each program will feature a panel of SEMVA members who will answer questions posed in by viewers.

Veterinarians answering viewers' questions will be Dr. Fred H. Gasow & his ranchman, Dr. William L. Mallon of Warren, and Dr. Morris Christlieb of Detroit.

As the calls come into the studio, phones will be answered by volunteer members who will relay questions to the Herrington. Among those answering the phones will be Southfield veterinarians Dr. Fred B.

Sladek, Dr. Joseph A. Watkins and Dr. Harold Suckler.

The series is made possible by a SEMVA grant to the television station.
