However, Joel with eight hearts and no diamonds decided to "sacrifice" in hearts.

West led the king of diamonds. Fortunately, West did not lead a club, for then there would be no story. The diamond was trumped in the closed hand and a heart was led to the ace. East was also reluctant to lead a club, hoping for two clubs tricks, and returned the jack of spades. Declarer played low, and West took the ace and returned a spade confident his partner had the king ten over the queen nine. Joel now had 11 tricks. The spade king, a club to the ace. Clubs were discarded on the queen of spades and the ace of diamonds.
