Some statistics about your bird

While you're carving the Thanksgiving turkey, use some facts about the big bird to tell company and ease their hunger pangs.

Over the past 25 years there have been significant advances in turkey production and those on most tables at Thanksgiving were grown for about 20 weeks, the average weight being about 20 pounds. But some 25 years ago it took 25 weeks to raise the same size bird.

These figures may not seem very impressive, but to the person who grows them they represent significant production cost savings, according to Dr. Bernard Marquet, Michigan State University poultry specialist. In 1950, a turkey required four pounds of feed to gain one pound of body weight, or 80 pounds of feed to grow a 20-pound bird. Today it requires 62 pounds of feed to produce a 20-pound bird, a reduction of 18 pounds of feed and four weeks' growth time.

Turkeys are very efficient feed users and grow quite fast, which is a credit to development of special breeds and new management techniques, says Marquet.

The optimum growth period for a hen is 14 weeks and 22 for a tom. Beyond that time the birds are less efficient in transforming feed to body weight. Typically females run 12-16 pounds and males are 22 pounds and up. These are about average weights for turkeys. They could be grown larger, but consumer demand doesn't call for birds over 25 pounds, says Marquet.

Turkey is traditionally a holiday meal, but now there are some advances being made for year round production and sale, says Marquet. The meat is now being processed into turkey hot dogs, turkey salami and meat pies. Turkeys that are fed and basted are injected with either oil or butter as they are being processed, which is supposed to help make the bird more moist when roasted.

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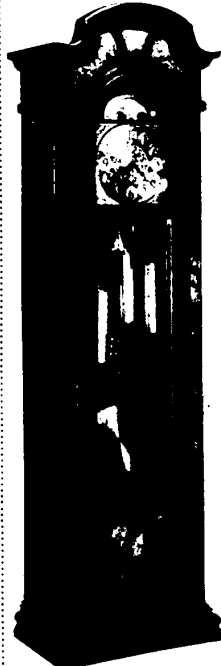
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
