

Kids collect for needy

Students at Southfield High School collected a small mountain of canned goods for the Southfield Goodfellows Christmas drive.

Students gathered a total of 6,100 cans of food, estimated at a value of \$2,000.

The food was picked up at the school last Thursday by members of the Southfield Fire Department and taken to the Southfield Civic Center. Goodfellows will distribute the food during the holiday season to needy Southfield families.

Cans were collected during a five-day period, ending Nov. 21, with the drive winding up Nov. 21. The cans were collected by students in the school's food classes.

Both classes tied for first place in the drive, turning in 1,000 cans each and were treated to a special dinner by the Southfield Goodfellows.
