

WTVS looks at 'Triangle'

Programs to watch for in the coming days and weeks:

Case of the Bermuda Triangle enters at 8 p.m. tonight on Channel 56. The program takes a scientific look at the region in the Atlantic Ocean where ships, planes and thousands of people have vanished.

There are spectacular tales like the disappearance of five Navy fighter planes on a routine training mission. The pilots had radioed in panic that they could no longer trust their instruments and the ocean and air suddenly looked alike. Then there was silence — no wreckage, no survivors.

The program contends that some facts have been ignored, exaggerated or falsified. "Strange disappearances" of small boats, for instance, often occur on days when the weather is bad in the area. And the proportion of disappearances of light aircraft in the "Devil's Sea" is about the same as elsewhere in the U.S.

BILL KENNEDY offers a delightful alternative to the football games Thanksgiving Day. At 1 p.m. on Channel 56, Kennedy presents "Little Miss Marker," a 1931 adaptation of Damon Runyon's story of a little girl brought up by bookmakers and racketeers.

The movie stars Shirley Temple, Adolphe Menjou, Dorothy Dell and Charles Backford.

On Friday, at 1 p.m., Kennedy offers "Young Tom Edison," a 1940 classic with another child star, Mickey Rooney. This biography of Thomas Edison's childhood takes a look at his first inventions and recalls the day he became the town hero.

Fay Banner, George Bancroft and Virginia Weidler also star.

LOU GORDON's guest at 10 p.m. Sunday on Channel 56 is The Rev. Kenneth Martin, a gay minister. Martin is scheduled to appear with "Spouse" Tom to discuss his philosophy of love, marriage, the gay life and the Human Cabaret Church.

Dr. Raymond Moody tells Gordon about his experiences with the dying and who he believes there is life after death.
