Lenore Frontczak is the recipient of a travelship to the American Association of University Women-United Nations Seminar in New York.

A member of the Farmington Branch of the AAUW, Ms. Frontczak is a public school music teacher, a private piano teacher, and has been teaching folk dancing to school, church and community groups since 1945.

She is the third Michigan woman ever to receive this grant from the educational foundation. The travelships are highly competitive, only ten were awarded last year throughout the United States.

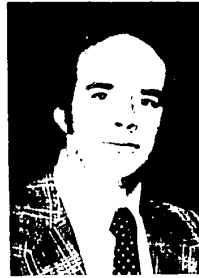
This year's seminar theme is "The Third World Woman." Participants will attend a general session of the UN and hear speakers from both the UN and AAUW.
