

This column describing volunteer needs in Oakland County is co-sponsored by the Junior League of Birmingham and the Oakland County Volunteer Bureau.

OAKLAND COUNTY JAIL REHABILITATION is looking for volunteer correction workers over 21 years of age and with some college work in social service. Duties include locating services and employment for released offenders, advocating for released inmates, and assisting in follow-up activities. Training is provided.

SOUTH OAKLAND COUNTY RED CROSS is in need of volunteers to assist in non-professional hospital duties providing care for patients that hospital personnel may not have time to give.

Duties vary according to individual hospital, but training is provided by both the Red Cross and hospital staff. Both the young people and adults are welcome. Time varies from one hospital to another, but one period per week is most likely.

Another area of service is that of special food needs caller. Volunteers telephone previous donors of specific blood types to determine their willingness to donate Red Cross blood. Every 100 blood mobile volunteers are assigned to teams usually near their own homes. Most mobile units require six hours of work, not necessarily every week. Volunteers serve as observers, bus drivers and registrars.

POSITIVE OPTIONS, a community agency interested in preventing juvenile delinquency is looking for volunteers for its Millard-based program.

The agency needs adults to chaperone evening youth activities, artists who would be willing to sell their work through the Art Hut on a consignment basis and instructors for sewing and pottery classes at the Hickory Haven Nursing Home. In addition, it seeks to establish a file of volunteers who would be willing to work on a one project basis as various needs arise.

Dr. Mitchell will explain and demonstrate the Pueristor system which was recently installed at Providence and which identifies and prescribes the correct formula for infants and children and drugs.

The Providence Hospital Community Health Education Series, sponsored by the Family Practice Center, presents lectures of public interest on the first Monday of each month. Subjects scheduled for the first four months of 1977 include: "The use of oral contraceptives, of estrogens and of progestins on the use of oral contraceptives."

A demonstration of methods of preparing holiday delicacies will be sponsored by the American Society of Women Accountants at 6 p.m. Tuesday, Dec. 14, at the Michigan Consolidated Gas Co., 1 Woodward, Detroit.
