But this year something happened to change that. Mrs. Miller won the award.

The AAUW salutes a woman once a year. AAUW Vice President Irene Cameron told organization members at a luncheon in the Hillside Inn "In the Observer Margaret Miller salutes women twice a week."

Mrs. Cameron said that the suburban life pages were not typical women's section pages that simply deal with card parties and entertainment.

Margaret has tried to contribute so much more by writing on women who have made a contribution," she said. "As women's editor she is always doing response reporting that is not frivolous, but contributes to the community. Her articles have promoted a community caring image of women."

Mrs. Cameron noted that for three years the AAUW has chosen at random three women who had contributed in a variety of ways to the betterment of Livonia's way of life.

"This year we changed course slightly," she said. "We now intend to pick categories of endeavor such as religion, social services, education and so forth. This year we chose media as our category."
