Persons wishing to register for the series may call the education office of the health department at 357-1400.  
Public health nurses will teach the classes, co-sponsored by the Oakland County Medical Society and various adult education departments throughout the county.  
Topics will include the mental health of the family and growth and development of the baby before and immediately after birth, labor and delivery and care and feeding of the infant.  
Films and other audiovisual aids are used to illustrate some of the topics and each class is taken on a tour of a hospital. Class size is limited to 12 couples.

## Ski tour center opens

Farmington Area Recreation Commission (FARC) and San Marino Golf Course have joined forces to open a new Ski Touring Center. Ski rental service, lessons and special events are all part of the center at the golf course on Halstead and Eleven Mile.

Hours are from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. seven days a week. The center is open now and will remain open as long as weather permits.

Charge for ski touring is \$2 per day which includes use of heated restrooms. A snack bar is also available.

Ski rental is \$4.50 for a half day, or \$6.50 for a full day, but if guests must rent equipment, the \$2 ski fee is waived.

The rentals are only for use on San Marino Golf Course, and acceptable identification must be presented at the time of rental.

Ski lessons are offered for \$3 per hour, from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m. on Saturdays and Sundays, and special group rates are available for lessons.

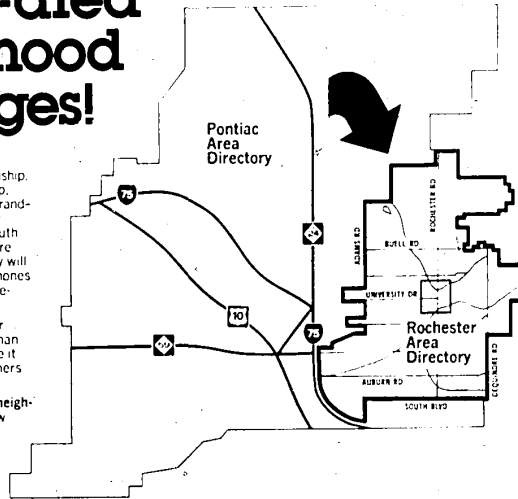
