Courts change hockey views

Dan Maloney, an aggressive hockey player for the Detroit Red Wings, came close to battling away his career last season at Maple Leaf Gardens.

Maloney knocked Toronto's Brian Glennie to the ice and repeatedly picked him up and slammed him down much like dribbling a basketball.

He was charged with assault and taken to court, only the third hockey player in the history of the National Hockey League to be criminally charged for actions on the ice.

"I think the court case has made many players change their style of hockey," began Maloney, who was acquitted of the charge.

"The way the NHL is set up today, it deters any aggressiveness with the intent to injure or punish. If you start a fight today, you're automatically kicked out of the game."

"I think the stiffer penalties are a derivative of the court case," Maloney continued. "I'm just happy that it's over."

The 6-2, 185-pound left winger, has played with three teams during his seven-year career.

Maloney was drafted in the first round by the Chicago Black Hawks in 1970. He was sent to the Los Angeles Kings during the 1972-73 season. In

1975 he was obtained by the Detroit Red Wings along with Terry Harper as compensation for free agent Marcel Dionne.

Maloney, who lives in Bloomfield with his wife and two children, expects to improve as a hockey player.

"Last year I scored 27 goals, 39 assists for 66 points. I feel I should improve on that this year," Maloney said.

"I'd also like to be a champion, and I think the Red Wings can do it. If we can string five victories together to keep up with the rest of the division, I think we can stay up there."

"We have a very young team, a young defense, and our forward lines have just been thrown together," said Maloney. "We've been getting great goaltending from both our goalies, and in time we'll be able to know everybody's moves, and we will be a much better team."

So far this season Maloney has 26 points—10 goals and 13 assists. Maloney's career high goal total is 27, his highest point output 66.

Maloney, seemingly headed for his best offensive campaign, has been sidelined with a fractured bone in his left shoulder. His arm is in a sling and he will not suit up for at least six weeks.

Prior to his injury, Maloney ranked third among Wing point-producers.

CITY COUNCIL MEETING
 December 20, 1976

The City Council of the City of Farmington Hills met in regular session at City Hall on December 20, 1976. Mayor Deacon called the meeting to order at 8:00 P.M. Council members present were: Dolan, Dudley, Lichtman, McConnell, Oppenheimer and Smith. Others present were: City Manager Majors and City Clerk Cairns.

Increase of \$4,200 in 1976-77 budget appropriation from unappropriated surplus towards completion of new fire station located on Middlebelt Road between 12 and 13 Mile Roads approved 6-1. Mr. Lichtman opposed.

Agreement to employ the Detroit Bank and Trust Company to act as Investment Advisor to the City's Pension Fund and increase of \$3,500 in 1976-77 budget appropriation from unappropriated surplus to pay fee for remainder of fiscal year was approved 6-1. Mayor Deacon abstained.

Planned Unit Development Agreement for Canterbury West Subdivision, located on the east side of Farmington Road between 13 and 14 Mile Roads was unanimously approved.

Low bid by Central Quality Services Corporation in the amount of \$159.80 a week to supply uniform rental for the D.P.W. unanimously approved.

Meeting adjourned at 10:45 P.M.
