Murphy to appoint Nowak deputy

Patrick Nowak, former Oakland County commissioner from Farm-ington Hills, is in the process of being

NOWAK COMPLETED a second two-year term as a member of the Oakland legislative body Dec. 31 and ad declined to seek reelection. His name became familiar in Lansing and state GOP circles in 1974 when Gov. William G. Milliken had him among the three finalists in the search for a running mate for lieuten and governor. RISING TO prominence in the Farmington Jaycees, Nowak was president of the Michigan Jaycees in 1970 and vice-president of the U.S. Jaycees in 1971.
