

Oakland actors in 'Naughty Marietta'

Michigan Opera Theatre's production of "Naughty Marietta" will feature a number of Oakland County singers and actors.

Southfield cast member Owen Anderson is featured as are Jan Albright and Mary Callaghan of Birmingham, Nancy Fuskas of Portiac, Robert Mounts of Rochester and Maggie Rees of Royal Oak.

Opening night is Jan. 14. In addition to the five subscription performances, there will be a performance at 8:30 p.m. on Saturday, Jan. 15. Tickets for this extra performance are available from the Southfield Arts Council which is sponsoring the event with the support of the Michigan Council for the Arts.

Buses have been chartered to provide transportation from the Southfield Civic Center, and a private reception will be hosted by the Southfield Arts Council for the cast following the performance.

Coloratura soprano Jan Albright will do the title role. She recently was a great success in "Lucia Di Lammermoor" on last season's spring tour of the Michigan Opera Theatre.

Mary Callaghan will portray Fanchon. She did the role of Kate Pinkerton in "Madame Butterfly" earlier

in the season. She attended Marian High where she performed in "Olivier," "The Heiress," "Hello Dolly" and "The Sound of Music." She has just graduated from Marygrove College, where she majored in theatre.

Owen Anderson will provide comedy relief in the role of Silas. He is a graduate of Southfield High School where he appeared in a number of productions under the direction of Robert Horner. He has appeared professionally with Patty Duke and John Astin and on the Lou Rawls TV show.

A foil for Silas is Lizette, portrayed by Nancy Fuskas. She was a finalist in the Grinnell auditions in 1969 and is a member of the Opera Organization under the direction of Richard Conrad.

Also appearing in the cast are Robert Mounts and Maggie Rees. Mounts has appeared in a number of community theatre productions in Oakland County. He has starred and directed for Stagecrafters in Clawson and Warren Community Theatre.

Miss Rees, a 16-year-old junior at Kimball High School, appears in the ensemble as a flower girl for her second performance with the Michigan Opera Theatre.

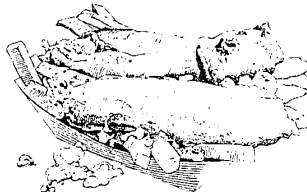
