

**CITY OF FARMINGTON  
COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS  
(Summary)**

A Regular Meeting of the Farmington City Council was held Monday, January 17, 1977 in the Council Chambers, 2600 Liberty Street, Farmington, Michigan. Present were Mayor John H. Richardson, Councilman Hartstock, Tupper and Yoder. Councilman Bennett arrived at 8:30 P.M.

Also present were City Mgr. Deandane, Director Jones, Director Byrnes, City Attorney Kelly and City Clerk Vance.

Minutes of the previous meeting were approved.

Minutes of other boards were received and filed.

Charles Amori, Farmington representative to Wolverine Boys' State, reported on his experiences at this year's Boys' State Program.

Mayor Richardson Knopf, Treasurer and the principals of The Old Winery, Inc., namely Mr. Charles Techner, Mr. Raymond Wade, Mr. Joseph Casey and Mr. Boyce J. Maxwell, in their request for Council's consideration and commitment of the Class C Liquor License available in Farmington for their proposed restaurant in the old winery building.

The following resolutions relative to this license were adopted:

Rescinding commitment to Mr. James Constand and to Mr. John White for a Class C Liquor License, as they have failed to act on the commitment.

Allocating the Class C Liquor License available in Farmington to The Old Winery, Inc. for a period of six months, pending the issuance of a building permit and investigation by the local police and the Liquor Control Commission.

City Manager Deandane was appointed Special Coordinator to the Michigan Municipal League for the 1977 Legislative Session.

Mr. Chester B. Anderson, 33297 Kingslane Court, appeared before Council concerning vandalism and the lack of prosecution for those committing crimes.

The following Proclamation was issued:

The Six Year Capital Improvement Program 1977-1982 which had been approved at the Farmington Planning Commission was received.

The following resolutions were passed:

Authorizing the expenditure of the funds received from the Anti-Recession Fiscal Assistance allocation under Title II of the Public Works Employment Act of 1976 to the Public Works Department Sworn Officer Salary Account.

Authorizing the employment of a part-time Accounting Clerk.

Authorizing the transfer of funds for temporary loans to the Federal Public Works Facility project from the General Fund or the Water and Sewer Fund.

Financial Report-Governing for the six months ended December 31, 1976 and the Water and Sewer Fund for the Quarter ended December 31, 1976 were received.

Monthly bills were approved.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:30 P.M.
