The city's first magistrate program is speeding up cases on the court's loaded docket, and new procedures are insuring more immediate hearings for defendants.

"The way it works is John Q. Citizen, for example, gets a ticket for speeding to miles over the limit," Faintuck explained. "The tration is payable over the counter.

"The ticket says if John Q. fails to pay his fine by the second Wednesday atter he was sused the violation, he must appear on that day for arraignment."

In the past, Paintuck said, the courset notice of violations to traffic of-fenders and waited three to four weeks. If the fine wasn't paid, the defendant was sent notice of trial and had t, wait another three to six weeks to appear in court.

"In a number of cases, traffic violators admit they're technically guilty, but they want to explain the circumstances," Faintuck said. "The arraignment system facilitates their getting

into court. Alleged offenders used to have to plead innocent to charges to be able to explain the incident to the judge."

IF A MOTORIST contests a trailic citation, he may be arraigned by Faintuck who enters a plea of guilty for the defendant and sets a specific date for trail. Magistrates are prohibited by law from hearing contested cases after arraignment proceedings. The also lack jurisdiction in mandatory court cases such as alcohol-related driving violations. 
