Less salt means more danger—AAA

Michigan's clean pavement era has stopped, and Automobile Club of Michigan is advising motorists to stay off state highways and county coads during periods of heavy snow to avoid accident. The State Highway Commission's decision to use less sail on snow-covered roads means that driving has become more difficult and hazardous han in previous years.' said James Moffat, autoclub general manager. Moffat added that most county road commissions in Michigan have reduced or, in some cases, marked with the commissions in Michigan have reduced or, in some cases, early eliminated overtime plowing and salting. In areas where overtime has been reduced exercely, county roads might not be plowed or sated on weekends or outside regular work hours on weekedays. "It is with great reluctance that we advise most of the production of the production

"However, we have an obligation to warn motorists that with reduced salting on highways, extra time will be needed to reach destinations during heavy snow periods and that road conditions could necessitate postponing or even canceling their best process."

Moffat pointed out that the highway commission's previous policy of getting down to bare pavement as quickly as possible by heavy salting has been modified. Most salting operations now are done following and not during a snowfall as in the nast

the past.

"This means that while major roads may remain passable even during severe storms due to plowing operations. many intersections, bridges and freeway ramps will be slippery and hazardous because of modified salting operations." Mof-lat said.

He stated that state and county road officials emphasize that near-zero weather and high winds made salting operations nearly impossible during and after the Jan. 10 snowstorm.




