

WOUX gets a new look

With a new general manager, new slogan and updated facilities, Oakland University's campus radio station, WOUX, is ready to fulfill its promise to become the campus communication center.

"We're gearing the station toward news," says Bob Sokoler, a young and energetic Southfield resident appointed general manager in January.

Since officially taking over his post, Sokoler has supervised the revamping of the station's system, rebuilding its facilities and the hiring of a student staff to operate the station from 7 a.m. to 11 p.m. Monday through Friday. Weekend hours are 8 a.m. to 11 p.m. Saturday and 10 a.m. to 11 p.m. Sunday.

Sokoler says a United Press International wire will be installed in the station in February, and he is beginning negotiations for an FM license to broadcast off-campus.

Originally from New York City, the 21-year-old radio manager worked for WDET's news department and as traffic department director for WNIC since he came to Detroit four years ago.

He left New York after working as a news reporter for WNYT and WRML, and tapes a syndicated radio talk show, "Trends for Tomorrow" at WNRC in New York.

Board race deadline set

You must be at least 18 years old and a resident of the Southfield school district. Those are the basic qualifications for anyone who wants to run for one of the two school board seats to be contested this spring.

Due to a change in the state school code, deadline for filing nominations for the race is April 11. The election is June 13.

For residents living in Southfield who are part of the Birmingham school district, where one four-year seat will be filled, the deadlines are the same.

Persons seeking nominations in Southfield, in addition to meeting the age and residency requirements, must file a petition with at least 50 valid signatures. Petition forms are available at the board of education offices week days. Birmingham school officials say they won't have forms available for about a week.

In Southfield, the two seats are presently held by Kenneth Larsen and Walter Johnson. Persons elected will take office after July 1 and serve four years. Board members serve without pay.

Southfield district voters going to the polls in June will also be asked to consider renewal of a school property tax. Nine mills of the school's operating millage expired Dec. 31, 1976.

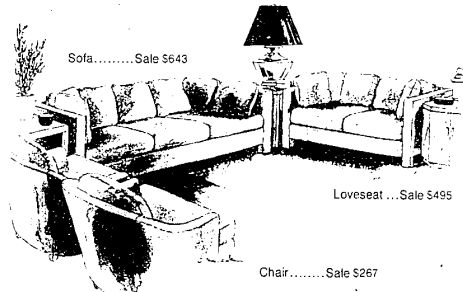

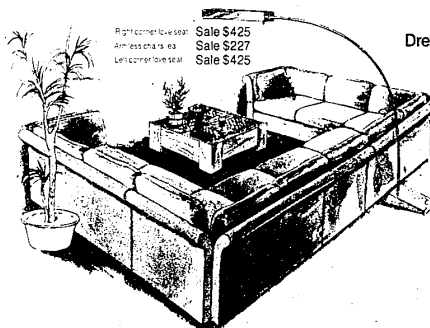
