

## City hall will offer fellowships

Southfield officials will consider implementing a student intern fellowship program to benefit the community and involve youth in local government.

Funds for the program may be available through federal education grants, according to Southfield City Councilman Stephen Cooper who suggested the project.

"The program would provide the city with student manpower to gather information for a variety of improvements," Cooper said. "These resources could be evaluated and used in applications for future funding of city projects."

"Not only would services be upgraded for citizens, but Southfield would be a leader among Detroit area communities with development of a student government training program. The city would be considered the employment base for local governments throughout Southeast Michigan."

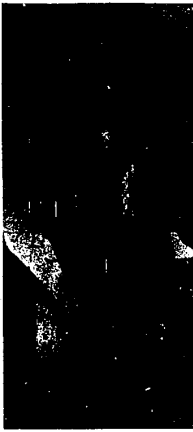
Members of City Administrator Peter Cristiano's staff have discussed the program with area university and school officials, Cooper said. Representatives of University of Detroit, University of Michigan-Dearborn and Wayne State University also are interested in participating, he said.

THE PROGRAM is proposed to be a pilot project involving college undergrads and high school students, Cooper said.

Two committees will be established to administer and monitor the program. The internship study committee would be responsible for policies, procedures and adaptations to meet the general concept, according to Cristiano.

The study committee will include representatives of participating universities, Southfield School District, the mayor, a member of Southfield City Council and a representative of the city administrator's office.

Another committee would select student candidates for the program after names are submitted by participating schools.
