There's a panoply of becoming hat looks to choose from at Hudson's Oakland Mall store. Designer Jack


O'Connell, for example, bands a natural straw hat with blossoms and girlsh velvet ribons feel amod befitting an Atlanta-born befle.

And for those with the inclination, but not the cash, there are basic straws and separae strings of flowers. Just loop then around as your mood changes.














