C'ville board election set

There will be room for two more on the Clarenceville Board of Education beginning July 1.

But anyone who is interested in running for the two available seats must file a nominating petition with the board no later than 4 p.m. April 11 to qualify for the June 13 election.

One of the openings is to fill a vacancy caused by the announced resignation of Thomas Wilson, who will retire June 30 with two years left in his term. He has been a member of the board for 10 terms. A successful candidate will serve the remaining two years, from July of this year through June 30, 1979.

The other seat becomes available

with the expiration of trustee Norman Hunt's four-year term on June 30. This seat will be a four-year term, running from July 1 to June 30, 1981.

Candidates must specify which term they are running for. Each petition must be signed by registered school electors of the Clarenceville district in a number equal to not less than one per cent of the total number of votes received by the candidate for the board who received the most votes at the last board election.

The number of signatures should not be fewer than 20. If a petition has more than the necessary one per cent, the excess will not be counted.
