

Localites involved in NCJW conference

A number of area women were present at the recent national convention of the National Council of Jewish Women in New York.

Almost 1000 leaders from NCJW sections throughout the country attended the convention to elect national leaders, to set NCJW policy for the coming two years and to attend workshops designed to further their training in NCJW areas of international, national and local concern.

A highlight of the convention was the presentation of the group's John F. Kennedy Award to the Vice President of the United States, Walter F. Mondale. His wife, Joan, accepted the award for her husband.

NCJW National President Esther R. Landa said the award is presented to an individual whose commitment has brought about social progress through legislation and whose dedication has improved the quality of life for the disadvantaged.

Experimental psychologist Dr. Martina Horner, president of Radcliffe College, presented the Hannah Stein Memorial Lecture, drawing on her re-

search findings in areas such as the psychology of women, changing family structure and the "fear of success" among American Women.


Many other prominent speakers including Andrew Young, United States Ambassador to the United States addressed the convention.




