Proposals

A new proposed township ordinance will be considered by the Farmington Township Board during its next regular meeting Aug. 26.

The public meeting of the board will begin at 8 p.m. in the township hall.

Township Attorney Joseph T. Brennan passed out copies during Monday's board session of an ordinance which would regulate trash containers with the suggestion that the ordinance be considered at the next meeting after the trustees had time to review the proposal.

Township Supervisor Curtis H. Hall said that the ordinance would do away with trash cans and replace them with a bin which the rubbish collector would provide.

Hall also gave the board members copies of a proposed resolution setting up the rest of the master water system for the township.

This would include the north eastern sections of the township.

The Board is expected to consider both matters Aug. 26.

A Library Technology Program which will prepare paraprofessional library assistants will be offered by Oakland Community College in the September session.

The OCC program will train students to assist in cataloging books, file reference data, compile bibliographic information and learn to manage the circulation of books and other materials.

An audio-visual department has become extremely important in modern libraries, and included in the OCC program will be an emphasis on audio-visual materials so that the student will become familiar with the handling of films, filmstrips, slides, and transparencies and will learn how to operate film projectors.

Courses will be taught at the Learning Resources Center (LRC) and the students will utilize facilities in the center as their resource library.
