Though all Christians regard the egg as a must for their Easter festivity, different nationalities participate in various traditions centering around the egg.

For example, northern Englishmen roll their decorated eggs down a hill, the Americans roll their eggs on the lawn of the White House, and the Greeks, Armenians and other Orthodox nationalities have fights, They bang each other's eggs, and the one with the damaged egg loses.

Today Easter is thought of by most people as the time of year to get a new outfit for Easter Sunday, to go to the grocery store to buy an egg-dye kit, and a few cartons of eggs, chocolate rabbits, and jellybeans.
