Tiger GM anxious

EDITOR'S NOTE: Just as the appearance of the robin designates spring, so too does the appearance of W.W. Edgar at Tiger Stadium designate the start of another baseball season. Edgar attended his 54th consecutive opening game last week.

These are anxious days for Jim Campbell and the rest of the Detroit Tigers' official family.

Seated in his office in the stadium shortly before the Tigers lost their opening game to the Kansas City Royals, he admitted that these were the most anxious days he has experienced in the past 12 years.

"I haven't felt this way since 1965," he commented, "when we brought the group of rookies in from the minors. This was the group that had Willie Horton, Bill Freehan, Mickey Stanley and the other youngsters who went on to win the pennant and the world series in three years."

Campbell's anxiety increased the next few hours when the Royals jumped off to a two-run lead and went out in front never to be caught on John Mayberry's three run homer in the fifth inning.

Campbell had seen Dave Roberts, the number two man in the pitching rotation, give up six runs, including two homers, in the first five innings. This performance caused Campbell to be more anxious than ever.

Prior to the game, he said, "If we can get two more starting pitchers out of the staff of youngsters we have now, we should be all right."

"We've built our hopes on power this year," Campbell said. "We have depth in power hitting and with the short left and right field fences, we should be able to score plenty of runs."

"This is a peculiar stadium," he went on. "You can't play defensive ball in it. Those stands are too close. A game could be taken away from you in a hurry."

That's just what happened in the opener. Before Roberts had retired two men in the first inning, the Tigers were trailing 2-0 on the strength of a long home run by Amos Otis.

From that point on, the Tigers had to try playing catch up baseball and the power that Campbell was anxious to see never did develop.

True, the Tigers did eventually get eight hits, but they were scattered and the Bengals' hopes were doomed when Mayberry, with the help of a strong wind, lofted the ball into the right field stands to seal the outcome.

Now, Campbell and manager Ralph Houk have reason to be anxious.

As Campbell turned back the clock 12 years to the last bunch of rookies from which a championship team developed, he admitted to being more anxious than ever now to know whether or this new group, with two more starters to go with Mark Fidrych, Roberts, Vern Ruhle and Ray Bare, can make a real bid for the pennant in the next three years.

"One thing I am sure of," Campbell said. "This will be an interesting ball club. It will be interesting to watch these young fellows develop. I sure hope they do. We will just have to be patient."

After watching the Tigers drop their opening game, the crowd of 46,807 is just as anxious as Campbell to see what happens.
