## Kidd gets life for murders

William Kidd was sentenced Monday to life imprisonment for his part in the murder of three men and an infant girl in a Southfield apartment 14 months ago.

Kidd, 26 of Detroit, was found guilty of four counts of second degree murder last month after a 21-day trial in Oakland County Circuit Court. He was sentenced April 11 by Circuit Judge William Beer. Kidd could be eligible for parole in 1988.

Norman Paintman, 35, of Detroit, was sentenced to mandatory life imprisonment April 4 by Beer after a jury found him guilty of four counts of first degree murder in connection with the multiple murders. Paintman's trial was conducted in Ingham

County Circuit Court in Mason because his attorney claimed Paintman couldn't get a fair trial in Oakland County.

Kidd and Paintman was charged with the Feb. 23, 1976 killings of Floyd McElhannon, 32, of Southfield; Theodore Nelson, 35, of Detroit; Raymond Brown, 22, of Detroit; and Brown's 2-year-old daughter Andrea.

The pair was arrested after police found the bodies in the living room of an apartment at 16200 Carriage Lamp Court. Each of the victims had been shot in the head.

The killings, said to be drug related, marked the first multiple murder in the history of City of Southfield.
