Landlord may oust blind woman

A blind Avon Township resident and her leader dog are caught in a tug of war with the Southfield owner of her apartment complex that could end with their eviction.

A notice mailed to Vicki Jackson and her husband Lester orders them to be out of their apartment by April 18

to be out or unen apartment complex in the Hampton development at Rochester and Hamilin roads have been exchanging a barrage of charges and counter-charges. The apartment manager says residents have complain that the Jacksons have not cleand up after the dog, while the Jacksons say winter weather made it dangerous to do so.

The Jacksons, who live on Evelyn Lane in the apartment complex, have gone through a mountain of red tape in their battle to remain in the Hampton apartments.

"We had a leader dog here before though," Boesky said. "We went out of our way to help the man and the dog. He's moved by now, but we didn't have any problems."
