

Landlord may oust blind woman

A blind Avon Township resident and her leader dog are caught in a tug of war with the Southfield owner of her apartment complex that could end with their eviction.

A notice mailed to Vicki Jackson and her husband Lester orders them to be out of their apartment by April 18.

The Jacksons and an apartment complex in the Hampton development at Rochester and Hamlin roads have been exchanging a barrage of charges and counter-charges. The apartment manager says residents have complain that the Jacksons have not cleaned up after the dog, while the Jacksons say winter weather made it dangerous to do so.

The Jacksons, who live on Evelyn Lane in the apartment complex, have gone through a mountain of red tape in their battle to remain in the Hampton apartments.

The two have been married for four months. Mrs. Jackson has had her dog Samson since August 1975.

The owner of the apartments, Southfield attorney Roger Boesky, and the Jacksons both say Samson was welcome to the apartment building though pets aren't allowed as a rule. Leader dogs are exempt.

"The reason we're being evicted," Lester said, "is because they got some complaints saying we don't

clean up after the dog. The only time we didn't was in the middle of winter when they didn't shovel the snow. My wife isn't going to break her neck out there taking the dog down to the drainage ditch behind us. And I'm not paying \$250 per month to go out there and clean up after every stray dog that shows around here."

MRS. ROBERTA WILLIAMS, manager of the apartments, was unavailable for comment but her husband said he thought it improbable Mrs.

Boesky would walk the dog, snow or not. Williams also said he had nothing against the dog and no one else did either, but he and his wife had written complaints on file. Williams also said he thought the dog might present a

"I guess the guy (Jackson) is just trying to get away without cleaning up after the dog," Williams said.

Leader Dogs for the Blind on Rochester Road in Avon Township, the largest school of its kind in the world. The dogs are allowed nearly everywhere except hospitals.

Samson, like all leader dogs, was trained at a cost of \$3,800 to the school and contributors including the Lions Clubs. Next week is Leader Dog week in Rochester and Avon and Oakland townships in honor of the the facility.

ACCORDING TO the Jacksons, the eviction notice was sent March 12, rescinded orally by both the owner's field representative, Paul Christensen, and apartment manager Mrs. Williams. It was then reinstated to give them only one week to move.

Both the manager and field representative and owner Boesky say the notice was never rescinded, but would have been had Jackson cleaned up after the dog.

Jackson claims Boesky has taped conversations between the two. He also has a mountain of correspondence pertaining to legal aid, and has signed petitions.

One document Jackson has was signed by three apartment renters who he claims use the same entrance and exit as he and his wife. The petition states the dog poses no problem. They also have a signed statement from their postal carrier stating the snow was not removed during the winter.

"This apartment has no maintenance whatsoever," Mrs. Jackson said. "Even when we moved in, we had to pay \$250 when the apartment was already filthy. We had to wash the walls ourselves." Jackson said he and his wife want to live in the apartment, nevertheless, to avoid being forced out. They hope to move into their own house eventually.

"I'M WONDERING what would happen if she didn't have me to handle this," Jackson said. "She'd be out on her own, and I imagine this has happened to other people."

Boesky said he had not personally been out to the apartments to check on the dog or the complaints.

"We had a leader dog here before though," Boesky said. "We went out of our way to help the man and the dog. He's moved by now, but we didn't have any problems."
