Books tell how to cook lakes fish



The most recent publication is an il-lustrated 34-page book entitled "Fishes of the Grand Traves Bay Region" Along with detailed penado, in the state of the Grand Traves Bay Region" Along with detailed penado, in drawings it provides extensive notes on the biology and natural his-tory of the fish. Tom Kelly, one of the authors and Sea Grant advisory serv-ices agent, says that the information in the book is applicable to many other regions besides Grand Traverse Bay.

"Great Lakes Fish Cookery" is a free 15-page cook book with advice on low to cook often-ignored species like burbot, carp, sucker fireshivater mulet and even the lowly alewife. All 90 recipes, for everything from Kalkaska Creole to the Petoskey Paprika Bake, have been kitchen-tested at Michigan State University.
