"Use Straw and Stover.

Practical experience as well as experimental work has taught that straw and stover can be used, very economically in the rations of almost all kinds of live stock., These roughages are and should be used in the fatteening and should compose a larger partiage, and should compose a larger partiage of all wintering or keeping rations for eartie, sheep, and horses. Breeding herds of here for the partiage was can be successfully kept on rations composed largely of these materials. Flocks of breeding ewes do well with such feeds when some grant is added. Horses deling very light or no work need little grain if given a pleentiful allowance of clean, bright straw or stover. Under certain conditions, of course, grain should be added to the ration, but it, should be conserved as largely as possible for human consumption.

These newspaper quotations present live cattle prices in hicago on December 30th, 1918.

The list shows price ranges nine general classified groups with a spread of \$13.85 per cwt. the lowest at \$6.50 and the highest at \$20.35.
