

Do not sow wheat on stubble it possible to avoid doing so.

Plow under all infested stubble and ruined wheat where practicable sodal after harvest, especially where this does not interfere with the growtig of clover and forage grasses.

Destroy all voluncer wheat by harvowing, disking, plowing, or otherwise.

Plow Early and Deep,

Plow all land to be sown to winter wheat ne early and deeply as existing conditions permit and prepare a thoroughly pulverized and compacted seed, bed.

Their chief weapon against their enemy, the snake, is their ability to inflate their bodies to twice their normal size, thus making it difficult for snakes to swallow them.

Very Deficient in Organic Matter of Are Subject to Blowing—Straw Covering Helps.


