RURAL ROADS NOT IMPROVED

Official figures show that there are in the United States approximately 2.500,000 miles of rural roads of which 12 pix cent are classed as improved. Road engineers, however, estimate that no myre than one-fourth of a per cent of the nation's roads are spitable, for mototruck traffic. More than 6,000,000 motor vehicles are now using the highways, and of this number about 500,000 are trucks varying from less than a ton capacity to vehicles capable of haulting five to seventeen loads. The most conspicuous example of anything approaching the efficiency of a nafoonal thoroughfare in the United States is the Lincoln highway. Organized as a private enterprise six years ago, to stimulate good-road building, the officers of the association have plasted several million dollars by privite subscription and have stimulated the improvement or imany sections of the highway by the states and commless through which it passes.
