FUEL SAVED BY GOOD ROADS

Wear and Tear on Trucks and Amount of Gasoline Consumed Shown in Recent Ohlo Test.

test conducted in Ohio recently A test conducted in Oblo recently to deterpine the saving in gasoline from running over a good road as compared with ages consumption over had and medium-grade runds, disclosed a surprising difference. Five new army standard "A" trucks with seven different types of road service, showed a galo of six niles per gallon of fuel between the hest and worst types of roads.
