The women from the Speaker's Bureau of the Detroit Institute of Arts have taken over the podium at Somerset for the Spring Art Lecture Series. The series continues on March 15.

Coffee and Danish are served at 9:30 a.m. in the mall auditorium on the lower level, and the lecture begins at 10 a.m. March 15, Mrs. Albert Matisse will talk about "Women in Art: A Neglected Story."

Mrs. Matisse was born in Toronto and attended Purdue University where she majored in architectural engineering. Since her marriage, in 1946, she has made her home from Texas to New York with a few stops in between. However, Orchard Lake has been the permanent address for the past 10 years. Since 1971, the Detroit Institute of Art has benefited from her service on the volunteers committee, Founders Society, docent committee and board of directors for which she was program chairman and historian. Mrs.

Matisse has been a member of the Speaker's Bureau since its conception in 1975 and her topic covers the prominent women artists, their lives and masterpieces at the DIA.

The March 22 program

will be "Art and Music: The Prophets in History" by Mrs. David Snyder. Mrs. Snyder's interest in art began at 10 when she won an award in a National Children's Poster Contest. Her technical training

begin at Cass Tech's fine arts department and she received her bachelors in art education from Wayne State. Mrs. Snyder taught art in the Detroit Schools for four years before retiring to raise a family.
