

Maimonides donor event

Doctors' wives aid med students

Renaissance Center fashions will be an important attraction at a Southfield luncheon on Tuesday, March 21.

The Women's Auxiliary of Maimonides Medical Society has chosen the first day of spring for their 32nd annual donor event to be called "Les Collections Internationales." A noon lunch at the Raleigh House will precede the show to be introduced by Madelyn Coe.

Clothing and accessories from the Renaissance boutiques of Carter Les Must, Charles Jourdan Shoes, Courreges, Halston, Lanvin and Valentino are featured with some of the area's top professional models.

For Mrs. Bernice Arnkoff, president of the auxiliary, the 21st of March will be the culmination of a year of planning and untold numbers of meetings. "I have a lot of memberships in the community, but Maimonides is where I have my commitment," she said.

Married to Morris Arnkoff and mother of three sons, two attorneys and one physician, she has been a

member of the Maimonides Auxiliary for over 22 years.

"We're all wives of doctors in the group, every one," she said. "We have nearly 500 members too."

ALTHOUGH Maimonides lists more than a dozen recipients of their philanthropic work, it is no secret that for Mrs. Arnkoff and most of the other doctor's wives, their program of medical scholarships is closest to their hearts.

"We give no interest loans to medical students," she said. "We have about \$180,000 in loans out at this moment. Often the money is returned with a dividend included."

Other beneficiaries of Maimonides' efforts are the American Red Mogen David, Kupat Cholim, Detroit Public Schools; visually handicapped; Jerusalem Institute for the Blind; the Samed Medical Center in Israel, Children's Hospital Center for Abused and Neglected Children and its Burn Center and the Co-operative Council of the

League of Jewish Women.

"We just gave Haverim House, a residence for retarded persons a large donation," she said.

The auxiliary hopes to have 800 at the luncheon.

"This is our one big fundraising effort," Mrs. Arnkoff said. "The committee has been just super. Everybody knows their job and they work right along. That means meshing a lot of very different personalities."

Southfielder Gail Tukul is chairman of the fashion show luncheon and Sheri

Michaels of West Bloomfield is ticket chairman. Past president Ann Silver of Birmingham is co-ordinator.

IN ADDITION to promoting fashion, the Maimonides women will also be selling a cookbook, "Favorite Foods" for \$5.

The bright yellow covered book is a collection of over 450 recipes, all easy to prepare favorites of club members.

Three eight-week series of expectant parents classes offered by the Oakland County Health Department will begin March 13, 14, 15 in the South Oakland Health Center, 27725 Greenfield, Southfield.

Registrations will be accepted by health department education office, 424-7058. The classes, running 7:30-9:30 p.m., are taught by public health nurses and co-sponsored by the Oakland County Medical Society and various adult education departments

throughout the county.

Topics include the mental health of the family unit, growth and development of the baby before and immediately after birth, labor and delivery, and care and feeding of the infant.

Films and other audio-visual aids are used to illustrate some of the topics and each class is taken on a tour of a hospital.

Classes are limited to 26 persons (13 couples).

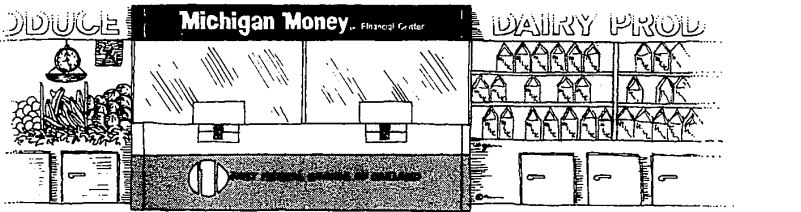
