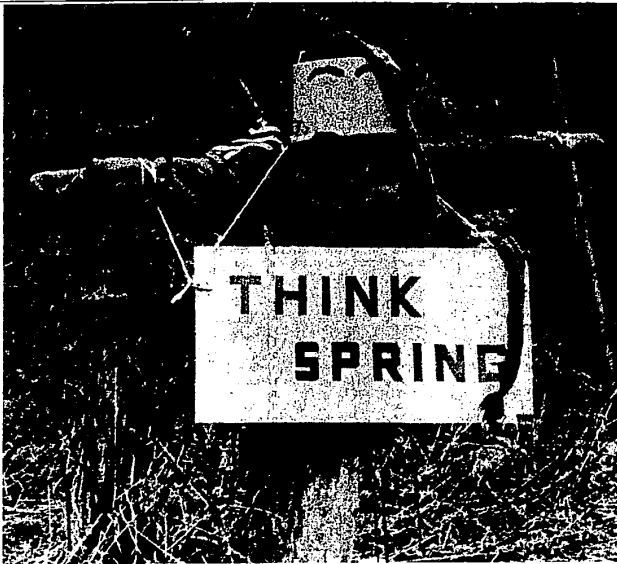


# How to get your news in the paper

- When you submit information for an article in Observer & Eccentric newspapers, keep in mind the following pointers. By heeding these recommendations, you will save delays and avoid errors.
- Be certain you give complete information. It's better to submit too much information than too little.
- When an individual's name is to be used in an article, be sure to give the first and last name. For instance, you and the members of your church may know that Rev. Smith's first name is John, but our other readers may not.
- Be certain that the information is readable. Illegible information is the prime cause of errors in any newspaper.
- Be sure to include your own name and phone number. If you have accidentally omitted information or if we cannot read your writing, we will have a means of checking.
- If you plan to submit a photograph with an article, be sure that it is a good one. A sharp black-and-white photograph is best, but even color photos will work if they are in focus and have good contrast.

## Driving deduction

The IRS rule allowing 17 cents a mile for the first 15,000 miles of business use of a vehicle is retroactive to Jan. 1, 1977. Employees who have been reimbursed less than 17 cents a mile should file an employee business expenses form with their tax returns and claim the difference as a deduction. This can be done even if you don't itemize.

## Art work of contemporary black South Africans shown

The only body of art work by contemporary black South Africans to be shown in America will be presented at the Detroit Institute of Arts from April 4 through May 14. Nine young African artists who studied at the Berke's Drift School in Natal on the border of Zululand are represented by 58 etchings and linocuts. "Black South Africa: Contemporary Graphics" was assembled for Detroit exhibition at the request of Michael Kan, deputy director of the art institute and curator of African, Oceanic and New World cultures at the Brooklyn Museum. The works concentrate on three themes—village life, contemporary urban life and Bible stories. "They have such an immediate appeal and represent so well the culture, lore, aspirations and problems of South African blacks that they almost interpret themselves," Duchac said.
