

In C'ville race

3 hopefuls vie for school spot

Three candidates will vie for two Clarenceville School Board seats in the June 12 election.

Robert Erickson, with 11 years on the board, is stepping down, but board member Daniel Morrison is seeking a second term.

Competing for the posts along with Morrison are Lorene Erickson, wife of the retiring member, and Michael Zahn, a political newcomer to the field.

Morrison, on the board four years, is a claim supervisor with Great American Insurance Co. He and his wife, Sharon, have nine children ranging in age from 3 to 21 years. They live at 19621 Antago, Livonia.

Morrison said his first term on the board was, "spent learning how things operate and getting the feel of the school district."

"I feel perhaps I can be of some assistance in giving children in the Clarenceville School District a better education. It's time we consider what we can do to improve the quality of education," Morrison said. He added that the board should improve the quality of teaching.

Morrison has been a Livonia resident since 1957 and all his children have attended Clarenceville schools. He graduated from Catholic Central High in Detroit, studied 1½ years at the University of Detroit and spent the years 1951-54 in the army, 1½ of it in Germany.

MRS. ERICKSON said she decided to run "because I feel I have a contribution to make. It seems like the right thing to do."

Mrs. Erickson has three children—

one married and two in Clarenceville schools.

She is coordinator for Project Action at Churchill High School in Livonia.

"This is a federal project in which we work with senior citizens as well as pre-school children," she said. "There are 20 volunteer teachers on the program."

Mrs. Erickson received her teacher certificate from Wayne State University in 1961. She taught in Detroit schools for two years and has been in Livonia since 1972. The family lives at 26345 Weyher, Livonia.

Zahn, 36, is a mechanic with BG Auto Repair in Redford. A 1969 graduate of Farmington High School, he was the owner of Mid-Seven Towing in Livonia for seven years.

He and his wife, Karen, live at 26335 Osmus, Livonia and have two children.

Christina, 4½ and Michael 1½. He attended Oakland Community College for two years taking an automotive technician course.

"This is the first time I've run for any position. I saw there was concern about the lack of persons interested in running for the school board and thought it was my duty to try."

"I don't know that I want a political career, but if I can serve the school board it will help and at the same time I can contribute something to the community."

He has been a member of the Livonia Jaycees six years and this year is a Jaycee director.

"Education is very important to me. My daughter will be going to a Clarenceville school before long," he added.

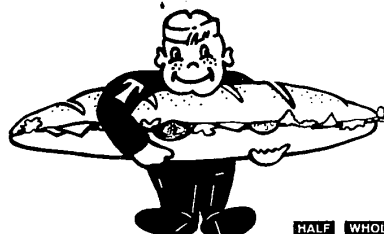
