## Activists cited by Israel Bonds

A Southfield man has been named as 30th Year Chairman and an area banker will be the recipient of the Prime Minister's Medal, Israel's highest award.

Phillip Stollman, a member of Israel Bonds Prime Minister's Club has accepted the position of 30th Anniversary Year Chairman. He will coordinate anniversary celebrations and commemorations on behalf of the bond organization, according to David B. Hermelin, general chairman.

Stollman said special awards, programs and presentations are being planned in order to activate members of the Jewish community toward observing Israel's 30th year.

"No country is stronger than its economy," said Stollman. "Israel's economic growth and progress, despite adversity, has been the crucial factor in bringing about the present possibility of peace, and Israel Bonds is the major supplier of loan fund dollars for roads and rail lines, telephone networks and power lines, port facilities, irrigation and much more."

Banker Stanford C. Stoddard, president of Michigan National Corp., will be the recipient of the Prime Minister's Medal. The prestigious award is presented in recognition of his achievements as a banker, and humanitarian, and for support of Israel's economic development as a sister democracy.

Hermelin said the bond organization is privileged to honor a man of such caliber and leadership.

The presentation will be made to him at a statewide dinner for Israel Bonds under auspices of a bank, the first such dinner in Michigan. It will be held on Sunday, June 18, at Kellogg Center at Michigan State University in Lansing.

Stoddard visited Israel in 1977 and said he "was greatly impressed by the economic projects created from the

bonds' funds. I am pleased, and proud, to be a contributor to this cause. To visit the country—to see it with one's own eyes—enables one to observe more Arab-Israeli harmony than the press would believe."

He has been a banker since 1964 and is active in many community activities as well. Stoddard was named Business and Professional Leader of 1977 by Religious Heritage of America and has been honored by civic, philanthropic and banking-related groups for his leadership.

In another announcement, Hermelin said that Sam Rothberg, national campaign chairman for Israel Bonds, will be present at an inaugural luncheon at 11 a.m. Thursday at the Holiday Inn in Southfield, where bond executive officers will be installed.
