

# Southfield policeman is hypnotized

## He gave help to Troy man on morning of his murder

Under hypnosis, a Southfield police officer has been able to recall additional details related to the January murder of a Troy man. But the new information, police say, has so far led to "nothing concrete."

Martin Iwrey of Troy was found dead about 1 p.m. Jan. 18 near the bank of the Rouge River near Telegraph and Civic Center Drive in South-

field. Medical examiners said later that Iwrey died from a blow to the head.

He had been reported missing Jan. 13 by his father, Seymour Iwrey of Hazel Park. Ironically, the younger Iwrey had been seen that morning when Southfield police spotted his 1966 light green Chrysler on the south side of Northwestern Highway.

Police said Iwrey asked them to help jump start his car, but they were

unable to do so because they lacked the battery jumper cables. Instead, they offered to drive him to a nearby gas station, Iwrey declined.

A short time later, police drove by his car and saw two men with jumper cables apparently assisting him in starting his car.

THE OFFICER who saw Iwrey with the two men is Ptd. Michael Folster. At the request of Southfield detective Gerald Stonebraker, Folster agreed to be hypnotized in an effort to recall details that might help police locate the men he saw with Iwrey.

Folster was taken to the Michigan State Police post in Northville April 13 and hypnotized by state police Lt. Ron-

ald Brauchne.

While in a trance, police said, Folster was able to recall two details that he previously could not remember:

"The car next to Iwrey's was a small brown Valiant, either a 1963 or 1964, with black sidewall tires."

"One of the men at the scene was wearing a checkered coat or shirt."

The new information, said Southfield police Lt. J. Harvey, has produced several new leads. "But so far," he admits, "nothing has been very concrete, yet."

A second police officer also saw Iwrey with the two men, but he has declined to undergo hypnosis, Harvey said.
