THE VEHICLE maintenance facility is equipped to handle all of the city's requirements for fleet maintenance. The salt storage building corrects past environmental problems with the storage of road de-sieng salt, according to Deadman.

The general contractor of the project was K. Pemberton Construction Co., Inc. of Livonia. Mechanical contractor was Evans Mechanical Contractors, Inc. of Novi.


