

Fisher Theatre slates 'For Colored Girls . . .'

"For Colored Girls Who Have Considered Suicide/When the Rainbow Enuff" will play a five-week engagement at Detroit's Fisher Theatre, May 16-June 18.

"For Colored Girls . . ." is not usual Broadway fare. Yet, this collage of writings by Ntozake Shange, as arranged by director Oz Scott and choreographed by Paula Moss, has received high critical praise and record-breaking audiences in New York, Washington, D.C., Boston, Cleveland, Chicago, Baltimore and Philadelphia.

The show began its odyssey in bars

and schools in the San Francisco bay area. Later, in New York, it was seen by Joseph Papp who, in association with Woodie King Jr., produced the show first at the Henry Street Settlement's New Federal Theatre, then the New York Shakespeare Festival Public/Auspacher Theatre and finally moved it to Broadway in September 1976.

"For Colored Girls . . ." will be performed at the Fisher Theatre-Saturday at 8 p.m.; Sunday at 7 p.m.; and Saturday and Sunday matinees at 2. No performance will be given May 18. Box office telephone is 873-4400.
