

Chorus staging 'Anything Goes'

The Ford Chorus will present "Anything Goes," a musical comedy featuring the words and music of Cole Porter at 8 p.m. May 11-12 at the Redford Theater, Lahser and Grand River, in northwest Detroit.

The musical comedy written by Guy Bolton and P.G. Wodehouse is this year's spring production of the Ford Chorus. Musical direction of the 140-member chorus is handled by Ray Kool, resident director, and stage direction is by Frank Jakes, assisted by Ned Jakes. Set design and graphics production is by Cliff Dixon.

"Anything Goes" was originally presented on Broadway in 1934, ran for 400 performances and was reviewed by critics as a "jubilant and expert affair."

Deems, Barbara Lang, Margery Gray, Kenneth Mars and Mildred Chandler in the lead roles. It was then awarded the New York Outer Circle Critics Award.

THE STORY takes place aboard the S.S. American cruise ship, sailing from New York to England. The plot involved a potpourri of temporarily mismatched characters who, despite their screwball distinctiveness, eventually "come appropriately together."

The coming together is impeded at times by a series of crack-brained, disruptive but well-intentioned shenanigans.

Music and lyrics by Cole Porter include "You're in the Top," "Ban-Voyage," "It's Delovely," "Heaven Hop," "Friendship," "Let's Misbehave," "All Through the Night," "Take Me Back to Manhattan," "Public Enemy Number One," "Be Like the Bluebird," "Blow, Gabriel Blow," "I Get a Kick Out of You" and, of course, "Anything Goes."

Prior to each performance, and during intermission, entertainment will be

provided at the console of the Barton pipe organ by members of the Detroit Chapter of the American Theater Organ Society.

Admission is priced for adults and for senior citizens and students. On opening night, May 11, however, students (through high school, accompanied by an adult) will be admitted free.
