

# Bank showcases student artists

"Moods and delineations," an exhibition of paintings, sculpture, pastel renderings, charcoal and pencil drawings and mixed media works of art by students of Marian High School, is on display at Detroit Bank & Trust, Fort and Washington Boulevard, Detroit through May 31.

Visitors can see the exhibit from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday-Friday at no charge.

Since 1971, Scholastic Magazine, which sponsors the Scholastic National Arts Awards Competition, has presented more than 25 regional awards annually to Marian students along with numerous blue ribbons, gold medals, gold keys and several four-year, full tuition scholarships for national achievement in art.

From a collection of more than 300 works of art, many of which are award-winning pieces, 90 were selected for exhibition at the bank. The show includes pencil and pen and ink drawings, oils, acrylics, etchings, textiles, tempera and transparent water colors, charcoal and pastel renderings, calligraphy and sculpture. One sculpture is a full-size representation of a woman sitting on a bar stool.

"Although still quite young, through their art students have already begun to make 'statements' reflecting their developing convictions, opinions, impressions and sensitivities about life and reality," said Marie Henderson, chairman of the school's art department.

Founded in 1959 by the Sisters, Servants of the Immaculate Heart of Mary of Monroe, Marian is a private Catholic girls' school. It is fully state accredited and approximately 90 per cent of its graduating seniors enter college.



"Friday Night at an Irish Pub" is a mixed media painting done by Joan McGuire of Birmingham at the beginning of her senior year at Marian High. Using tempera watercolors and conte crayon, the painting is on a large grocery bag. In order to achieve the textured appearance, the artist tore the bag into abstract shapes, glued them onto a second bag and used the top layer for her painting surface.

# DCD announces summer programs

Detroit Country Day School has announced a variety of summer programs.

- Summer enrichment and tutorial school for boys and girls in grades 5-12 will be held June 26-July 28 from 8:30 a.m. to noon. Subjects include writing workshop, mathematics (\$350 each) and a college board preparation course (\$225).
- Gifted students. Three different courses—computer programming and enrichment mathematics, encounters in chemistry and biochemical reactions—will be offered June 26-July 28 for fourth through eighth graders. Cost is \$90.
- Summer study skills. This emphasizes organizational skills, research, speaking, listening and writing skills. It will be offered June 26-July 28 for \$30.
- Summer day camp. Applications are being accepted for boys and girls aged 6-12. Camp will be June 26-Aug. 4, Monday through Friday, 9 a.m.-3 p.m. Tuition is \$140 for each two-week session.

• Tot lot camp. For boys and girls aged 3-6. Sessions will run from June 19-July 7 and July 10-July 28. Cost is \$175 for each three-week session.

• Camp Gateway. For physically handicapped children 6-12 years of age. It will be held June 26-July 21, from 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. The camp stresses recreational activities. Cost is \$75 for one week; \$150 for two weeks; \$220 for three weeks and \$280 for four weeks. This includes lunch and a T-shirt.

• Sport camps. For tennis and soccer buffs. Brian Marcus, a leading professional instructor, will head the tennis camp. He can be reached at 355-0662 for information on times, prices, age groups and enrollment.

The soccer camp is for 8-14 year old boys and girls. It will be held July 10-July 14 and July 17-July 21, from 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Head coach will be Neil Rust.
