

HE TRACED his break with the administration on the Middle East to last October when, he said, "like arcoket" came the U.S.-Soviet joint statement about the area, "a document clearly drawn by the Soviets which called for a new partnership." Moynihan said the agreement also called for a Palestinian state to be formed by the PIO (Palestinian Liberation Organization) and caused shock and outcry everywhere. "The Soviet Union is niterested in peace in the Middle East," he said. "They want choos, revolution and war. President Saidt was sufficiently alarmed to make his visit to Israel in December.

"The downfall of Sadat would be the Soviet's first price to extract if they ever got back into Egypt. Can you imagine what the Soviets do to someone who throws them out if they get back?"

He noted that after the March 12 terrorist attack in Israel, Radio Moscow called it a military operation and referred to 30 Israeli sodiers killed. "The words of Yasser krafta (PLO leader) are the woment weathulary of Soviet propaganda," he said. "I believe that what is happening to our policy in the Midesat and the world at large is a gradual accommodation of the fact that the USSh has become the equal of the U.S. in military power and political influence."

He said that just last week, a military coup in Afghanistan put into power not the generals but a community government, giving the Soviets access to mountain passes leading into India, "which they have long sought."

"WHY ARE we associating our-selves with ideas that come out of Moscow?" Moynthan asked. "The U.S. has given in to the USR and is depict-ing Israel as an upstart, illegal nation. "Israel has proven they could not be beaten in battle, so the Soviets strive now to beat them with work. Begin-ning in 1971, the wort began to come out of the USSR that the Jews were not the victims of the Nazis but their successors."
