Polio is riskier than vaccine

Recently I read about a child who got paralytic polio after receiving the live (oral) polio vaccine. I'm afrald to continue the immunizations my child is supposed to have, but she can't go to school without them. Isn't there more danger of getting a disease with the vaccine than without it?

No. The charac of getting para-tive polio following the adminis-tration of the oral polio wacetine is less than one in 10 million doses, according 10 Dr. Thomas Shope of the infectious diseases division at Cildren's Hospital. But the risk of paralysis if you catch natural polio is one in every 1,000 cases. In addition, Dr. Shope questions whether all of the cases of polio attributed to the vaccine were, in reality, caused by it.

it. Some people have suggested that the killed polio vaccine (Salk) be used instead of the live, oral one. But the Salk vaccine requires continuous booster injections, while the original series of oral polio vaccine gives lifelong immunity without boosters. The

Salk vaccine is recommended only for those rare people who have defective immunity. Under no circumstances should you allow this small area of controversy to interfere with protection for your child. Pediatricians all over the country are concerned about the 20 million children who are inadequately immunized. President Carter has launched a national campaign to immunize the children by October 1979.


Another recommended vaccine is for dighteria, pertussis (whooping cough) and tetanus, commonly known as DPT. This is given at 2, 4 and 6 months of age, at the same time as the oral polio vaccine. It is repeated at 18 months and before entering school.
