

# Students earn merit scholarships

Two North Farmington High School students have been tapped for merit scholarships by the National Merit Scholarship Corp.

They are: Jeffrey Hildebrand, 28268 New Castle, and Gary Roshak, 29947 Fernhill, both of Farmington Hills.

The average annual stipend for a college-sponsored merit scholarship currently is about \$750, or \$3,000 over four years, depending on a determination made by the corporation. Amounts to individual students remains confidential.

Students applying for the scholarship are rated on high test performances on scholarship exams, consideration of high school principal recommendations, and presenting a record to support high academic standing.

**WINNERS ARE** selected by officials of a sponsoring college, which also computed the students' financial need and determined the individual stipend. Hildebrand, whose fields of study are electrical engineering and political

science, was awarded his scholarship from Washington University.

Among his honors are Presidential Classroom for Young Americans, Purdue summer engineering seminar, varsity debate and forensics, and North Farmington High School marching, symphonic and stage bands. He was in the mixed and select choirs, was the German Club's president and graduated with high honors.

Roshak, whose field of study is applied software science, received his

scholarship from Rochester Institute of Technology in New York. He is an Eagle Scout, a member of the 1975 Blue Lake Fine Arts Camp in national Band and was runner-up of the Junior Achievement officer of the year. He belongs to the Detroit Chapter of Phi Beta Kappa, National Honor Society and the Flint Youth Honors Orchestra.

The two students were among 1,795 students from around the nation who received the honor.
