A minimum investment of \$10,000 is required and there are no fees. Your Money Market Certificates are insured

8-Year Investment Certificates paying 7¾% annual interest rate.

Should you have a long-term savings goal in mind, you can now purchase an eight-year Investment Certificate and earn 7¾% annual interest, paid right from the date of deposit and compounded quarterly. A minimum deposit of \$1,000 is all that's

needed to open each 8-year Investment Certificate. Federal Reserve regulations require a 3-month loss of interest and the payment of any remaining interest at a reduced rate if redeemed prior to maturity.
