

Stan Kenton and his band kicking off P'Jazz

Lionel Hampton and Fats Domino, whose 1977 P'Jazz appearances broke all previous attendance records for the outdoor concert series, are among the many big name groups scheduled for Chuck Muer's P'Jazz this summer.

The seventh season of concerts on the terrace of the Hotel Pontchartrain begins Wednesday with Stan Kenton and his band. Performances will take place each Monday and Wednesday

(with the exception of July 3) until Aug. 30, starting at 6 or 6:30 p.m. through 10 p.m.

Following Kenton, the Wednesday night series continues with Lionel Hampton, Brookside Jazz Ensemble with Ursula Walker, Jimmy Wilkins, Austin/Moro Band, Thad Jones/Mel Lewis, Chico Hamilton, Stanley Turrentine, Woody Herman, Herbie Mann, the Interlochen Jazz Band and closes

Aug. 30 with the Duke Ellington Orchestra.

Dizzy Gillespie leads off the Monday series on June 19 followed on successive Mondays by Les McCann, Brookside Jazz Ensemble with Ursula Walker, the Tommy Dorsey Orchestra, Lonnie Liston Smith, the Kingston Trio, Maynard Ferguson, Chubby Checker, Fats Domino and the Austin/Moro Band with Jack Brokensha.

TICKETS FOR reserved seats and tables can be purchased through the P'Jazz ticket office at Hotel Pontchartrain (868-0200, ext. 1755). Ticket office hours will be 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday-Friday. As before, general admission tickets will be available at the door beginning at 5 p.m. the day of the concert.

Reserved seat tickets and general admission is priced for local groups

and big-name artists.

Last year's P'Jazz performances attracted the largest crowds in its history, with attendance averaging 2,000-2,500 per concert.

"We will remain our casual format, with plenty of room for standing and mingling before performances and during breaks," said Ole Christensen, general manager of Chuck Muer restaurants at the Pontch.

"Refreshments, including hot sandwiches, soft drinks, cocktails, beer and wine will be available at more locations than in the past to improve service," added Christensen.

Valet parking is available at the Larned Street entrance to the Pontch. Several large parking lots in the vicinity, including the garage at Cobb Hall across the street, remain open evenings.

Youngsters performing

Young people from the Detroit metropolitan area will have an opportunity to perform on a legitimate theater stage when the Birmingham Theatre begins its Kiddie Vaudeville Show on Sunday.

The opening performance of the vaudeville show will take place at 1 and 4 p.m., with additional performances of Kiddie Vaudeville throughout the summer.

Dozens of talented young people from Birmingham, Southfield, Livonia, Detroit, Warren and as far away as Ypsilanti auditioned earlier this spring for parts in the upcoming production.

Some of the acts selected for the show include tap dancing gorillas, an accordionist, acrobatic jazz, and a three-year-old Detroit who sings and dances.

Tickets bought for Kiddie Vaudeville will have part of the proceeds donated to the Sippy Sales 8th Annual Telethon for the Retarded.

Kiddie Vaudeville will be presented under the direction of Jonathan Haglund, who will emcee as well as perform mime. Kiddie Vaudeville is part of an ongoing Children's Theatre Series which is being coordinated by Martha Keller and Carol Hill.

Bank closes Paradigm

The Paradigm, natural foods restaurant in Birmingham's Continental Market, has been closed. Also closed is The Gazebo, adjoining The Paradigm, in the market at 210 S. Woodward.

Pamela Pupp, who owns both The Paradigm and The Gazebo, said that the Oakland County branch of Michigan National Bank foreclosed on Thursday.

"They padlocked it that morning," she said.

According to Ms. Pupp, "I had a continual battle with the bank on a lot of different levels." She said there will be litigation and that she is hiring a new attorney.

"My concern is for my patrons," Ms. Pupp stressed. "I've been there two years. This is not the end. The Paradigm will remerge, but maybe not at this location. I've had too many problems here."
